Ali Rosato Toscana



The grapes are harvested at the end of August. The bunches are selected by an optical sorter and then crushed. The juice is then left in contact with the skins for 2 hours. After pressing, the fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks.

The name Ali means "wings" in Italian and it is also the name of the winery owner Lia Tolaini-Banville's "little angel": her daughter. The artwork from the label is a detail of Cupid from the original artwork for the Bramosia Chianti Classico label by Rik Olsen.

Grape varieties : Sangiovese

Altitude : 350m A.S.L.

Vineyard age : 20 years old

Grape yield : 7 t/ha

Soil : Lime and clay, with a considerable presence of gravel

Donna Laura Ali Rosato is a pure Sangiovese showing a light pink color. The nose displays hints of strawberry, red cherry and pink grapefruit. The palate is fresh and vibrant and has a pleasant and long-lasting finish.
